

Mississippi Community College Faculty/Staff Tuition Remission Form

Delta State University is excited to offer a special tuition benefit to Mississippi community college faculty and staff. Full-time community college employees are eligible to receive a reduction of one-half tuition. To be eligible, the applicant must meet standard admission requirements. Tuition remission can be applied toward undergraduate and graduate courses, including those taken as a non-degree seeking student.

Instructions: The MSCC faculty/staff member must be fully admitted to Delta State University. <u>Once</u> <u>enrolled</u>, the employee can submit this form to Graduate and Continuing Studies via email at <u>grad-</u> <u>info@deltastate.edu</u> (phone: 662-846-4700; fax 662-846-4313). <u>Please note that forms are accepted</u> <u>no earlier than</u>: July 15 for Fall; November 15 for Spring; April 15 for Summer I; and May 15 for <u>Summer II. A new, and separate, form is required for each term of enrollment</u>. Individuals must notify Graduate and Continuing Studies if employment ends and are responsible for all balances owed to DSU.
