Students who wish to audition should be prepared to sing a solo of their choice with either CD or cassette tape accompaniment tracks. Any type of solo, such as pop, contemporary Christian, country, or Broadway, will be appropriate. (Only background vocals are allowed on the accompaniment tracks.) After a brief orientation session, the students will participate in a group dance audition where they will be taught several styles of choreography.

On the day of auditions, students should bring the AMBASSADORS AUDITION INFORMATION SHEET along with 2 letters of recommendation from a teacher, principal, church worker, or employer. Students should also bring a copy of their high school transcript that shows their ACT score.
