Beverly Tolbert Terrell has been selected as the 2009 Humanities Teacher at Mississippi Delta Community College. She is currently in her twelfth year as an Instructor of Music at MDCC. At MDCC, she teaches Music Appreciation, Music Theory and Fundamentals of Music. She is also the accompanist for the MDCC Singers and Ambassadors Show Choir.
