



Mississippi Delta Community College Enrollment Increase Greenville Higher Education Center

Mississippi Delta Community College's enrollment for Fall 2009 shows a total headcount of 3,419 which is an increase of 8.9% over Fall 2008. Total credit hour production is 45,659 which is an increase of 9.3% over Fall of 2008.

Dr. Larry G. Bailey, President of MDCC, states:

The duplicated headcount for the **Mississippi Virtual Community College** shows an enrollment of 748 for Fall 2009 as compared to a headcount of 340 in Fall 2008.

The **Greenville Higher Education Center** shows an enrollment of total duplicated headcount for Fall 2009 of 728 as compared to a headcount of 505 in Fall 2008.
