

## **PRE-HEALTH SCIENCE**

The Pre-Health Science curriculum is recommended for students seeking admission to the Associate Degree Nursing Program who have not attended college. To be classified as Pre-Health Science, a student must have a composite ACT score of 16 (12 if earned prior to 10/28/89) or higher. It is also recommended for students who have a 16 or 17 on the ACT, who have been out of school for more than 3 years, or who feel the need to strengthen their academic background before applying to the program.

Students who pursue the Pre-Health Science curriculum should be aware that:

- taking the pre-health science curriculum does not guarantee admission into the Associate Degree Nursing program. (See the Policy on Admission to Health Science Programs).
- following the pre-health science curriculum does not lead to an associate of arts or associate of applied science degree.
