CAPS AND GOWNS

1. Caps & gowns will be issued to graduates in the Admission Office on the Moorhead campus. They are currently available for pick up through August 11, 2020.
2. **Graduates must present their MDCC ID card in order to receive a cap and gown.**
Graduates should return the cap and gown to the Automotive Technology area of the Career Tech Building

PROCEDURE FOR Thursday, August 13, 2020

1. Graduates should arrive at the Coliseum **NO LATER** than 9:00 a.m. to begin lining up their vehicles under Campus Police supervision. The procession will start approximately at 9:20 a.m. College staff will be present to offer assistance.
2. A member of the Faculty will give the invocation.
3. Dr. Tyrone Jackson, President, will welcome all and present opening remarks.
4. Teresa Webster, Vice-President of Instruction, will present graduates to the President for the conferring of degrees.
5. The President will confer the appropriate degrees upon the graduates. Tassels are to be worn on the left side. Do not change sides after the conferring of the diploma.
6. Graduates are to turn in caps and gowns to the Automotive Technology area of the Career/Tech Building.
