STUDENTS IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

Fall 2020 (Late Start Session)

Classes begin October 19, 2020
Drop/Add October 19-20, 2020
Charges will be incurred after the NO Show Date October 28, 2020
(A student is considered a “No Show” if there is no documentable engagement with the course content within the timeframe allowed.)

Your MDCC instructor will designate weekly attendance markers. You are allowed 1 absence (missing 1 attendance marker) in the late start session classes; therefore, on your 2nd absence you will be cut from the course. Be sure you understand the instructor’s policy if taking a course from another school.

Mid-term exam proctored dates November 9-12, 2020

First day a MDCC student may withdraw from a MDCC course November 18, 2020

Last day to withdraw from online courses affecting other schools.. November 27, 2020

(Student may NOT take the final exam and withdraw).

Final exam proctored dates.....December 3, December 7-9, 2020
