



NOTICE OF VACANCY

Associate Degree Nursing (RN) Clinical Adjunct Instructor

This position requires clinical teaching in freshman and/or sophomore level for Associate Degree Nursing (RN) courses. In addition, the instructor will be expected to:

1. work in conjunction with the Dean of Health Sciences, Director of Nursing, the Chair of the Associate Degree Nursing Program and Associate Degree Nursing faculty to ensure a coordinated delivery of clinical instruction and identification of student needs,
2. communicate the goals, objectives, and expectations of the clinical component to the students.
3. demonstrate an interest in the students by providing assistance in the areas of guidance and academic counseling as needed.
4. keep accurate records of student attendance, grades, progress and retention data.
5. evaluate students' achievement of student learning outcomes and program outcomes.

Under the direction of the ADN program chair, the adjunct instructor primarily facilitates student clinical learning within the program of study. The adjunct instructor prepares for clinical instruction utilizing the prepared course outlines and objectives, instructs and evaluates students, reports progress, participates in the assessment process, supports the program director to ensure effective program operation, and maintains appropriate expertise and competence through continuing professional development. The instructor is accountable to the ADN Program Chair, Director of Nursing, and the Dean of Health Sciences for fulfilling the position responsibilities.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must hold a Master's Degree in Nursing or hold a Bachelor's Degree in Nursing and be enrolled in a graduate nursing program. Applicants must have a current, unencumbered license as a Registered Nurse to practice in Mississippi.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT

The position will be classified as an adjunct (as-needed) position dependent on enrollment.

SALARY

The salary offered will be based on current MDCC adjunct/dual enrollment and/or part time salary policy. Mileage is compensated up to a maximum of 80 miles per day of travel at the federal mileage rate for a round trip from your residence to clinical location.
