Logging into Canvas

Students should begin logging into Canvas, MDCC's Learning Management System, on Friday, December 8, 2023. Final Proctored Exam

A proctored exam means you will have to come to the Moorhead campus and take the final exam in person with your instructor/proctor on Thursday, January 4, 2024. A testing schedule will be made available through your instructor and will be posted on the Canvas Home Page. If you have two exams scheduled at the exact same time, just report to one of them at the scheduled time and make prior arrangements with your instructor to find another time the **SAME DAY** to take the other final. **A photo ID will be required.** A driver's license, a student ID card from MDCC or your current college, and a military ID are all acceptable forms of ID.

Withdrawing from Class

Students may withdraw up until Thursday, December 7, by 3 p.m. without penalty. After this time, students will have to withdraw through the instructor and will be assessed charges for the course.
